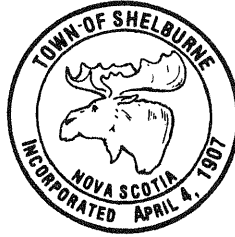
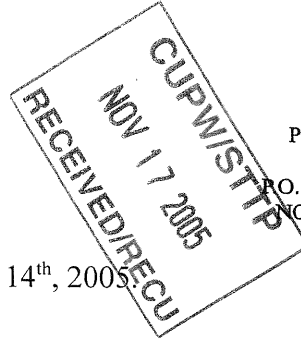


Hon. Mr. McCallum:

At the Regular Meeting of Town Council held November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2005, the following resolution was passed:

“Resolved that the Town of Shelburne write to John McCallum, the Minister Responsible for Canada Post, and request that the Federal Government instruct Canada Post:

- (1) to stop the closure of the mail sorting plant in Quebec City and proposed closures in other locations;
- (2) to consult with the public, postal unions, and the major stakeholders to develop a uniform and democratic process for making changes to the Canada Post’s network;
- (3) to maintain, expand and improve our public postal network.”
