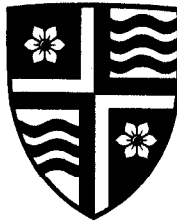
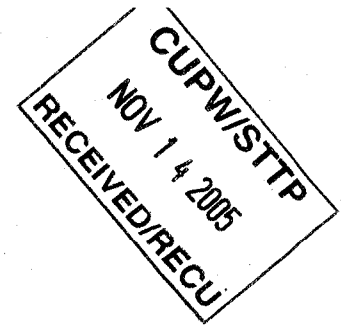

**Re: Post Office and Plant Closures**

At the November 7, 2005 Township of Langley Special Council meeting, Council passed a motion in support of the Canadian Union of Postal Workers' call for the stop to the closure of the mail sorting plant in Quebec City and the proposed closures in other locations.
