Dear Mr. McCallum;

The Town of Hanna Council is concerned about Canada Post review of its entire network and the announced plan to close the mail sorting plant in Quebec City as a first step in the review. The Government's position in allowing Canada Post to close rural post offices in spite of a moratorium on post office closures in rural and small towns is unacceptable.

Hanna Town Council approved the following resolution at their regular meeting of Council held on November 8, 2005.

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Federal Government** instruct Canada Post:

- To stop the closure of the mail sorting plant in Quebec City and proposed closures in other locations.
- To consult with the public, postal unions and other major stakeholders to develop a uniform and democratic process for making changes to the 'Canada Post's network.
- To maintain, expand and improve our public postal network.
